The Alberta 5 Pin Bowlers' Association and the Central Alberta 5 Pin Bowlers' Association wish to offer a warm welcome to the High Low Doubles Provincial Championship. Good luck with your bowling and we hope you have an opportunity to visit some of the attractions within our community.

Please take the time to carefully read over the following information and correctly fill out the forms with all the necessary information.

As bowling will take place on two shifts it is important that the zone contact advise the teams as to which shift they will be bowling on, as well as advising the host committee. **Each zone is entitled to have 6 teams bowl on each shift.**

We can use 16 lanes on the first shift and 14 lanes on the second or vice versa. If it is beneficial to a zone to have seven teams on one shift and five on the other shift, then the committee will consider such a request and advise the zone whether it can be accommodated. (preference will be given to the northern and southern zones first, due to the distance they have to travel. ABILITY TO USE 7-5 OR 5-7 ARRANGEMENT WILL BE DETERMINED ON **MONDAY, MARCH 22ND**, AND THE REQUESTING ZONES WILL BE ADVISED)

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Tournament rules are found in the current the Canadian 5 Pin Bowlers' Association Handbook.
2. All Canadian 5 Pin rules are in effect. Please make sure you are aware of any rule that may affect you.
3. Registration forms must be completed in full to be valid. A photocopy of individual highest league average as of **April 3rd, 2010**, based on a minimum of twenty-four (24) games having been bowled. (Must be attached to your registration form).
4. Tournament format: Five (5) games, total pins over average.

Note: In case of a tie and rolloff requirement, the Shift one winner will be required to stay until the end of the second shift . Failure to stay automatically moves the missing team into the lower position.

DRESS CODE

ALL PARTICIPANTS WILL ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING "DRESS REGULATIONS"

- **SHIRTS and/or SWEATERS**

Men - Must have sleeves and collar.

Ladies - Must have sleeves and finished neckline.

- Designs and Logos will be approved at the discretion of the Tournament Committee

- **PANTS / DRESS SHORTS, SKIRTS or SKORTS**

- Must have straight hemmed bottom.

- Must be a solid color. (no fluorescent colors, stirrups, spandex, ruggers, leggings, harem, sweat pants of any kind)

- **HATS and/or CAPS**

- Head Wear will not be permitted unless it is for religious or medical reasons.

BOWLERS DISREGARDING THE DRESS CODE WILL BE ASKED TO CHANGE.

FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION OR A FINE BEING LEVIED AGAINST THEIR ZONE.
